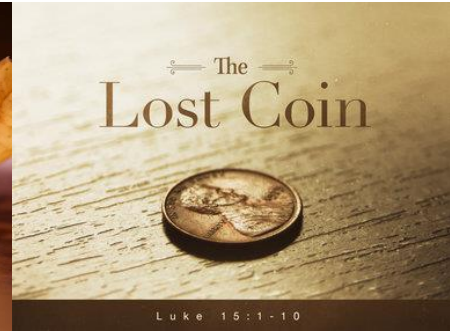
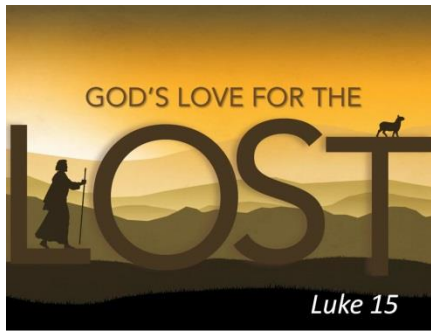


# Thy Kingdom Come, Day 5
