Some Scriptures : Revived, rejuvenated, restored, regenerated, healed, delivered

Revived – *Psalm 80:18 & 85:6* - Revive us and we will call on your name, will you not revive us again?

Restored - *Isaiah 38:16* - You restored me to health, *Psalm 51:12*- Restore to me the joy of your salvation

Healed - *Isaiah 57:19* - Peace, peace to those far and near. And I will heal them.

Psalm 41:4 - Heal me, for I have sinned against you

Comforted - *Psalm 23:4* - Your rod and your staff , they comfort me. *Isaiah 40:1* – Comfort, comfort, my people, says the Lord
