Useless Sinners

One of the unexpected successes of the Alpha course has been the development of Prison Alpha.

At the root of Prison Alpha's success is the message of redemption. Prisoners don't need to be convinced that they are sinners. Having been convicted of a crime and put behind bars, they know that society judges them as sinners deserving of punishment. Yet, presented with the gospel message of forgiveness of sin, redemption and the chance of a fresh start, Prison Alpha has led thousands of imprisoned men and women to faith in Jesus Christ.

The truth is that we are all sinners, whether or not society deems those sins to be worthy of imprisonment. As 1 John 1:8 states, 'If we claim to be without sin, we deceive ourselves and the truth is not in us.' Yet the promise of the cross is that 'If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness.' (1 John 1:9).

This is no passport to heaven without demanding anything of us. Like prisoners released, we are given complete liberty, but not liberty to do as we like, but to respond to God's amazing love and grace, living live lives worthy of the one who paid the price of our sins.

The wonderful promise of the New Testament is that even when we do fail, and fall back into sin, confession and repentance offers a chance for a new start, whatever we have done. It's a liberating truth. **Jason**
